This installation documentation applies to Suzuki Grand Vitara vehicles with a Diesel engine - for validity, see page 2 - from model year 2006 up to 2010 and later, assuming technical modifications to the vehicle do not affect installation, any liability claims excluded. Depending on the vehicle version and equipment, modifications may be necessary during installation with respect to the installation documentation.

However, the stipulations in this "installation documentation", the "operating instructions" and the "Installation instructions" for the *Thermo Top C/E* must always be observed.

The corresponding rules of technology and any information from the vehicle manufacturer should be observed during the installation work.

### **General Instructions**

Installation should be carried out according to the general, standard rules of technology. Unless specified otherwise, fasten hoses, lines and wiring harnesses to original vehicle lines and wiring harnesses using cable ties.

Sharp edges should be fitted with rub protection (split-open plastic hose).

Spray unfinished body areas, e.g. drilled holes, with anti-corrosion wax (Tectyl 100K, Order No. 111329).







### **WARNING!**

- Disconnect the battery "earth" or "ground" connection.
- Depressurise the cooling system.
- Copy the factory number from the original type label to the duplicate type label.
- Remove years that do not apply from the duplicate label.
- Attach the duplicate label (type label) in the appropriate place.
- Completely remove the battery.
- Open fuel tank cap, ventilate tank.
- Close the fuel tank cap again.
- Remove underride protection
- Remove A/C control panel in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
- Remove the lower cover of the footwell on the front passenger side.
- Remove the A-pillar trim on the front passenger side (only with Telestart).












Wiring harness routing diagram










1 Pin 1 of G52 connector on contact side




















### **Coolant circuit**

### **WARNING!**

Any coolant running off should be collected using an appropriate container. Install hoses so that they are kink-free. Unless specified otherwise, always fasten using cable ties. Position clamps so that no other hose can be damaged! When installing the hoses, the heater must be filled with coolant. The connection should be "inline" based on the following diagram:






All not designated clamps = 20-27mm dia. hose clamps Position **X** = original vehicle spring clamps. **1** Connecting pipe = 20x20mm dia. with 27mm dia. spring clip







Install fuel line and metering-pump wiring harness so that they are protected against stone impact. Unless specified otherwise, always fasten using cable ties.

Mount the fuel line and wiring harness with rub protection on sharp edges.












### **Final Work**

### **WARNING!**

Reassemble the disassembled components in reverse order. Check all hoses, clamps and all electrical connections for firm seating. Insulate and tie back all loose wires.

Only use manufacturer-approved coolant. Spray the heater components with anti-corrosion wax (Tectyl 100K, Order No. 111329).

- Connect the battery.
- Fill and bleed the coolant circuit according to the vehicle manufacturer's specifications.
- Adjust digital timer, teach Telestart transmitter
- Make settings on A/C control panel according to the "Operating Instructions for End Cus-
- Place sticker "Switch off parking heater before refilling" in the area of the filler neck
- For initial start up and function check, see installation instructions






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### **Operating Instructions for End Customer**





#### Note:


We recommend matching the heating time to the driving time.

Heating time = driving time

### Example:

For a driving time of approx. 20 min. (in one direction), we recommend not exceeding a switch-on time of 20 min.

In vehicles with passenger compartment monitoring it must be deactivated additionally, besides deactivating the vehicle settings for the heating operation.





#### **WARNING!**

The fording capability and the off-road capability of the vehicle are limited due to the parking heater being installed on the underbody.

Massive mechanical effects on the underbody (e.g., through floor contacts) are to be avoided! The vehicle may be immersed no further than the underside of the body. The heater should not be operated during water crossing.

Non-observation of these instructions can lead to the heater being damaged.

Damages on account of such non-compliance are not covered by the warranty!

Before parking the vehicle, make the following settings:



The "Circulating air" operation indicator flashes during heating.
