These installation instructions apply to vehicles Peugeot 607 with 2.7 I HDI engines – re. validity, see page 2 – from model year 2005 and later, assuming technical modifications to the vehicle do not affect installation, any liability claims excluded. Depending on the vehicle version and equipment, modifications may be necessary during installation with respect to these installation instructions.

However, the stipulations in the "installation instructions" and "operating and maintenance instructions" for the *Thermo Top C/P/E* are to be observed in any event.

The corresponding rules of technology and any information from the vehicle manufacturer should be observed during the installation work.

#### **General Instructions**

Installation should be carried out according to the general, standard rules of technology. Unless specified otherwise, fasten hoses, lines and cable harnesses to original vehicle lines and cable harnesses using cable clips.

Sharp edges should be fitted with edge protectors (split open plastic hose).

Spray unfinished body areas, such as for example bore holes, with anti-corrosion wax (Tectyl 100K, Order No. 111329)!







- Remove years that do not apply from the duplicate label.
- Attach the duplicate label (type label) in the appropriate place.
- Remove the engine cover.
- Remove the engine compartment panelling
- Remove the cover on the central electronics
- Disassemble the wiper arms.
- Remove the cooling water reservoir cover.
- Open the tank cap, ventilate the tank.
- Close the tank cap again.
- Remove the underride protection
- Disassemble the right and left wheel-house panel.
- Remove the bumper.
- Remove the footwell panel on the passenger side.
- Remove the glove compartment.
- Fold back the foot mat/carpet around the A pillar on the left.
- Completely remove the rear seat.















Cable harness installation diagram


### **Preparing the Installation Location**



Disassemble the alarm control Fasten the 30mm spacer nut to original vehicle stay bolts. Fasten the alarm control to the spacer nut with the original vehicle bolt and body washer.







### **Final Work**

#### **WARNING!**


Check that all hose lines, hose, spring band clamps and universal clips, and all electrical connections are securely fastened.

Secure all loose cables using cable clips.

Spray heating unit components with anti-corrosion wax (Tectyl 100K, Order No. 111329).

- Connect battery
- Start engine, bleed water circuit according to the vehicle manufacturer's specifications, top up with cold water.
- Set the time switch.
- Set the vehicle heating with automatic air conditioning or without automatic air conditioning according to the "operating instructions for the end customer".
- On vehicles from 10/2005, use the vehicle diagnosis to set the air conditioning control to auxiliary heating.
- On vehicles from before 10/2005, the air distribution flap is on the foot area.
- Auxiliary heating is **not** possible when driving. Therefore, you must switch off the heater on the heater unit controller since otherwise the pre-set heating time will not expire.
- Check that the auxiliary heating operates properly, see operating instructions / installation instructions.
- Apply the "Switch off auxiliary heating before re-fuelling" sticker onto the left side of the B-pillar


